Wood Worker's Show – Ray Smith

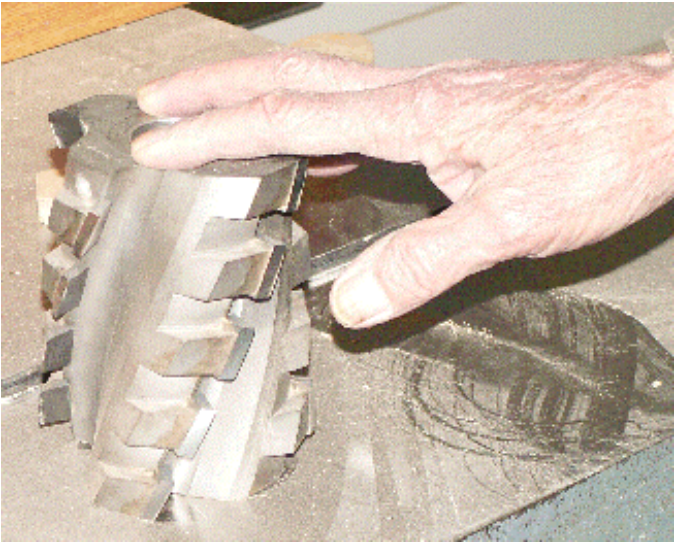
